SUBJECT: Asbestos Cloth Tape

Asbestos cloth tape, style F-330, .033" thick, is supplied to the Steel Division by American Asbestos Textile Corporation, 1032 Stanbridge Street, Norristown, Pennsylvania, 19404. The various widths of asbestos cloth tape used to protect electrical wiring from flame and extreme heat has the following code numbers:

1 3/4"	Width	Code	3120	555
1"	"	"	3120	545
1 1/4"	"	"	3120	540
2"	"	"	3120	560

On September 15, 1972, Nello Corsi, 3664, an electrician in department 1733 went to Central Medical Service for treatment of a dermatitis condition on his legs and body which he stated was caused by wearing Company issued coveralls. He also stated at that time, that he had been using asbestos cloth tape which caused irritation to his hands and arms. A sample of the asbestos cloth tape used by the employees was left at your office for laboratory tests to determine if employees using this tape should be given annual physical examinations.
