

1 amounts of heavy narcotics for any degree of
2 management.

3 It is pretty miserable.

4 Q Now, Doctor, I would like to show you what
5 has been part of a slide that -- CT scan from May 10th
6 of 1993 which is 24-F.

7 Now, this is a period of approximately seven
8 months between -- six or seven months between this CT
9 scan and the CT scan in May of 1993?

10 A About six and a half months.

11 Q Has there been, from what you can see on the
12 chest X-ray, any progression in the changes?

13 A Yes. In fact, I picked this particular cut
14 through the chest because it is a fairly similar cut,
15 the same level, similar level to the cut here to be
16 able to compare and contrast, and there are a few
17 things to show.

18 First, again, you can see, I believe, there
19 is now even less air in the left lung than there was
20 previously, so this is now fully involving most of the
21 left side of the chest, this mass.
