Subject: SPECIAL ASBESTOS SURVEY

On April 10 and 11, 1978, Mr. T. Carapezza and the writer investigated employee exposure to airborne asbestos at the locations listed on the attached data sheet. Airborne concentrations of asbestos dust were found to be well below the OSHA Permissible Exposure Limit at the operations investigated. It should be noted that the recent installation of local exhaust ventilation at the load-unload work station has resulted in a tenfold reduction in employee exposure.
