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Dear Mr. Hall,

On behalf of the National Rural Electric Cooperative Association (NRECA), I am writing to request a brief call to share some thoughts on implementing your memo of March 12 on "Implementing National Enforcement and Compliance Initiatives Consistently with Executive Orders and agency Priorities."

NRECA represents nearly 900 not-for-profit, independently owned electric cooperatives that provide power to 42 million people across 48 states, covering 56% of the American landmass. Those characteristics make it comparatively more expensive for electric cooperatives to operate than the rest of the electric sector, which tends to serve more compact, industrialized, and densely populated areas. America's electric cooperatives are critical partners in the Trump Administration's commitment to jumpstart the American economy and share the Administration's vision of a pro-energy future for the country.
