Pushbutton Stations

IMPORTANT: Where "emergency run" feature is specified for a magnetic controller with remote pushbutton station, the means for obtaining same may be either combined with the remote overrid relay reset button, if furnished, or provided by a separate remote pushbutton which does not by pass the start button, and which may be located in the common master-switch enclosure.
