My dear Mr. Mitchell:

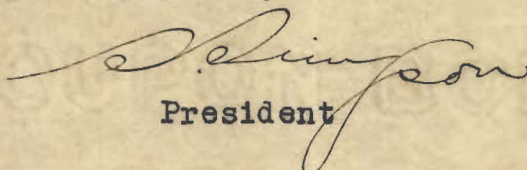
SUBJECT: Ben Garvis.
