We share with you the problem analysis investigation report (PAIR) related to the restriction proposal on PFAS in firefighting foams. The PAIR (pages 1-17) summarises the approach taken for the preparation of this restriction and the main elements of the Annex XV dossier but also describes the issues identified so far, the planned actions and a specific question for you to consider.

Since the Annex XV dossier is built on the version prepared by the consultant Wood (joint DG ENV-ECHA study of 2020) it is also provided here for reference (following the PAIR document, starting page 18 of the attached file). However, please note that this draft Annex XV report is still work-in-progress

and will need substantial amendments based on new information being collected since the publication of Wood's study. Therefore, we suggest that you focus your review on the first 17 pages of the attached document.

We would appreciate receiving your feedback by 11 June, if possible.
