

1 MR. SMITH: Thank you, Your Honor. I won't
2 go through them all. I want to show you them
3 briefly.

4 First one is filed in 1957 with a worker
5 which included Kaylo, 1957, 1958. Mr. Carroll worked
6 with Kaylo, also, choked on dust, one of the documents
7 in the file.

8 MR. McGOWAN: Your Honor, that is something
9 the lawyers compiled.

13 based on a lot of documentation that OCF has produced

19 happy to put into evidence the underlying OCF
20 documentation that establishes these names and dates.
