Dry Powder Stains are used in the finishing rooms of most woodworking factories who stain their products and who require a permanent color. The stain is used in the proportion of from two to eight ounces to a gallon of hot water. Many finishers add a half to one ounce of Bichromate of Potash to the gallon when making up their stains. This modifies the tone of the stain, produces a brighter effect and has a tendency to give better penetration.

If any of the above stains do not give just the right shade desired, combinations of any two or three can be made with very satisfactory results.
