We are looking forward to seeing you all in Ada, Oklahoma for the Region 6 State and Tribal Environmental Leaders' visit to US EPA ORD's Groundwater, Watershed and Ecosystem Restoration Division. This one-day meeting Tuesday, August 14 will begin at 8:00 AM and conclude 4:30 PM. Attached please find the logistics sheet, including hotel information. The closest airport is Oklahoma City (OKC).
