

When the Flag is displayed on the same halyard with another flag, it should always be at the peak, except during church services conducted by naval chaplains at sea, when the church pennant may be flown above the Flag.

During the ceremony of hoisting or lowering the flag, or when the Flag is passing in a parade or review, all persons should face the flag, stand at attention and salute. When not in uniform, men should remove the hat with the right hand, holding it at the left shoulder so the hand is over the heart. Civilians without hats and civilian women should place the hand over the heart. Aliens should stand at attention. The salute to the Flag in a moving column should be rendered at the moment the Flag passes. During the Pledge of Allegiance, the salute is rendered standing with the right hand over the heart, from beginning to end.

When the Flag is on a speaker's platform, and displayed flat, it should be above and behind the speaker. It should always be displayed flat, should never be used in any form of advertising, or as a receptacle for receiving, holding, carrying or delivering anything. When displayed before an audience, the Union should be to the right of the audience. If the Flag is on a staff, it should be at the right of the congregation.

The Flag should be hoisted briskly, but should be lowered slowly and ceremoniously.

When flown at half staff, it should be hoisted to the peak for an instant and then lowered to the half staff position. Before lowering the flag for the day, it should be raised again to the peak. Hoisting is used on the flagstaff only by order of the President.

Drunk Bike Riding Brings Jail Term

ROSEVILLE, May 12.—(INS)—Boy Libbey, 25 year old New York ranch worker, today began serving 100 days in jail for driving a stolen bicycle while intoxicated.

Edith Fairman, 14 year old Roseville boy, reported the theft of his bicycle when he emerged from a theater. Several hours later Libbey was nabbed by State Highway patrolman as he weaved along the highway.

"I only wish there were 4,000 of you instead of 400," he said, "because that would mean just

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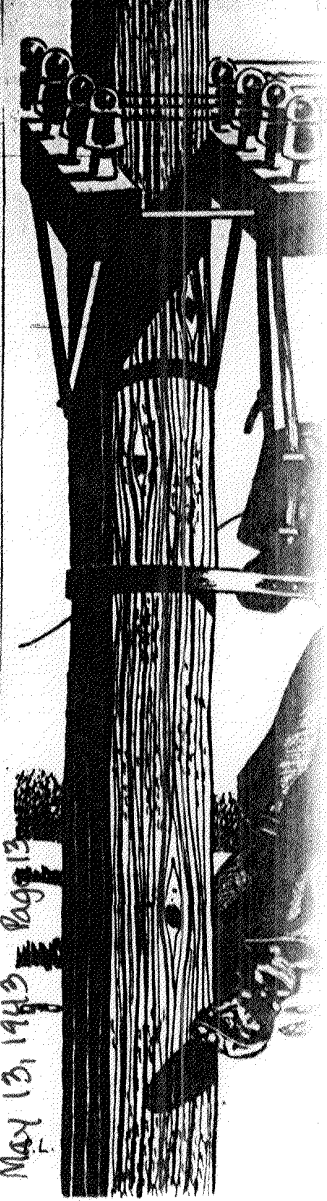
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
