* 8622 - LEAD FREE TOY ENAMEL--GOOD HOUSEKEEPING:

Mr. Mills called to the attention of the Board an article in "Good Housekeeping" on the danger of toys painted with an enamel containing more than 1/100 of 1% of lead. It was pointed out that we can formulate without lead driers and without dry colors containing lead but that it would be very expensive to manufacture without even a trace of lead.

Mr. McDowell will be asked to write "Good Housekeeping" and find out the authority for their statements and the standard by which products are judged.

A check will also be made on whether there have been any suits or complaints on our products used on toys.

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
