In further reference to the Tetra Ethyl Lead Area Committee's report on handling of tank cars returned with gasoline residues, I am attaching hereto recommendations for procedure submitted by the Inspection Department of the Standard Oil Company of Ohio for safety precautions. After your Committee has had the opportunity to examine this report, and if they are agreeable to the procedure recommended, we suggest that the plan be adopted either as given or modified to suit actual conditions, as soon as possible.

Relative to your Committee's suggestion to changing our refinery practice of washing cars with gasoline, I have already forwarded you Mr. Walter's and my own opinion on this subject and I am attaching hereto copy of letter from Dr. Kehoe giving his opinion, which you will find is the same as that of Mr. Walter and myself.
