Dear Lewis:

What is the status of the medical portion of your studies in the asbestos industry? As you know, Pittsburgh Corning Corporation is interested in the U.S.P.H.S. following up on the environmental studies at their Tyler and Port Allegary Plants as soon as possible. We are also awaiting the reports on these environmental studies.

You may remember I indicated to you that prior to U.S.P.H.S. involvement in the Tyler Plant we had discussed with Dr. Hurst, of the East Texas Tuberculosis Hospital, the possibility of their conducting medical studies on the Tyler employees. When it appeared that the U.S.P.H.S. would include the Tyler Plant in the asbestos industry study, we deferred further discussion with Dr. Hurst.

I have attached a copy of a letter recently received from Dr. Hurst which is self-explanatory.
