As stated in the referenced memo, Mr. Charles Almer spent two days (7/10/72 and 7/11/72) at the Burlington Q. C. Laboratories. During this time Mr. Almer had the opportunity to observe and take part in Gas Chromatographic Analyses of Plasticizers and Analyses of Plasticizers in compounds via Gaschromatography. In addition, Gaschromatographic Techniques, column selection and method developments were discussed. Qualitative and Quantitative Infra Red Analyses, such as Raw Material Identification and Bound Acetate Analyses were demonstrated. Mr. Almer observed sample preparation for and operation of the Brabender Extruder for Gel Determinations and Roller Head Analysis of Torque.

A plant tour of both Resin and Compound Plants provided Mr. Almer with a good background of the operations at the Burlington site.
