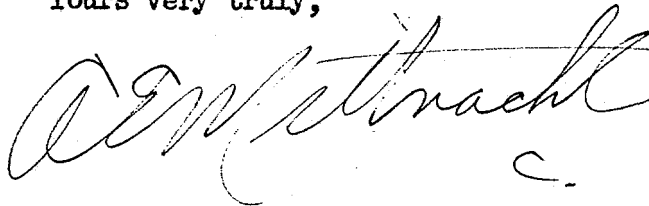
Dr. R. A. Kehoe,

Dear Dr. Kehoe:

Referring further to your letter of July 1st with regard to Kendall Refining Company having been reported as making split drum mixes, Tom Ronan in a recent visit to Bradford obtained the unqualified statement from Mr. Crawford that they had not split drums in any of their mixes at that refinery and that he has insisted on the men following the procedures laid down when Mr. Kaley made the original mix. He is completely at a loss to understand how the men showed signs of lead absorption.

This is about the report that you would expect in this case but we think that he now appreciates our position in the matter and we have his guarantee that there will not be any split drum mixes made in his plant in the future.

Dear Mr. Mittnacht:

As you are probably aware, there have apparently been many instances of transferring of full drums of ETHYL Fluid from one refinery to another. We have based this statement upon the fact that many drums are returned from companies and destinations other than those to which these drums were originally shipped.

It appears to me that this practice is a potential source of trouble and hazard from shipments of ETHYL in less than carload quantities. Presumably these shipments are not accorded the same care and supervision as is given them when shipment is made under our supervision by either the personnel at the plant or the District Managers.

For your information, we are listing herewith record of transferred drums for the first eight months of this year, showing point to which the drums were originally shipped and the record of transfer as taken from the origin of the returned empties. We have lined up the following information according to divisions in case you might think it advisable to have our respective District Managers make an inspection.
