Dear Hank:

In response to your telephone call of this morning, I should like to express my considered opinion, that it would be the better part of wisdom and procedure, in relation to the hygienic problems which are in our minds and those of representatives of Pure Oil concerning their use of AK-31X, if I were to talk with their responsible people about the situation at some early time, in company with the appropriate commercial representative (s) of Ethyl.

The establishment of hygienic policy, in relation to local and general health officials, should be agreed upon, among other things, so that we do not have to contend with problems created by persons outside Ethyl Corporation. We must, I believe, keep these matters entirely in our own hands, since the future of AK-31X is much more important than the small matters of marketing a small quantity of the product at this time.

I can go to Chicago on September 23, 24 or 25, or on September 30, or on October 7, 8 or 9, so far as my schedule has been established.
