Thank you for your letter of July 12, 1955, confirming our telephone conversation with respect to the problem of Mr. Simon Rubin, whose child had been eating blue paint from his crib.

I telephoned Mr. Rubin's home and talked with Dr. Marvin Small, 61-26 Marathon Parkway, Douglaston, Long Island, who was called on the case.

I explained to Dr. Small that it was very unlikely that the Du Pont blue paint involved would have contained lead pigment. Dr. Small stated that the Rubin child looked all right to him and that he did not consider hospitalization necessary.

Since we have heard nothing further from this case, I presume the matter is closed.
