HOUSING MAINTENANCE CODE: MAINTENANCE BY OWNERS -

Relating to lead poisoning in paint.

AN ORDINANCE

Amending Chap. 72 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances relating to Housing Maintenance Code; Maintenance by Owner. (95-2)

The City Council of the City of Minneapolis do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Section 72.020 of the above entitled ordinance be amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

No exterior wall of any dwelling or building accessory thereto shall have accumulated paint containing more than one percent of lead if said paint is blistered, cracked, flaked, scaled or chalked away.

No person shall use white lead paste paint for painting the exterior of any dwelling or building accessory thereto.

Section 2. That Section 72.030 of the above entitled ordinance be amended by adding thereto the following:

No person shall use paint containing lead pigment for painting the interior of any dwelling or dwelling unit.

No porch, interior door, window, or trim surface below a level four feet from the floor shall have accumulated paint containing more than one percent of lead.

No interior wall, floor, or ceiling, or interior door, window, or trim surface above a level four feet from the floor, shall have accumulated paint containing more than one percent of lead if said paint is blistered, cracked, flaked, scaled or chalked away.
