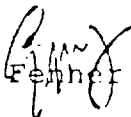

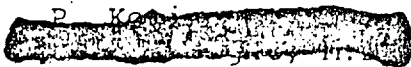
Present were Paul Kotin, M.D., G. W. Wright, M.D., M. J. Cowan, W. B. Reitze and E. M. Fenner.
