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FERODO "FZ" BRAKE LINING

Ferodo "FZ" Lining represents a recent development by Ferodo Engineers of a semi-molded type for internal brakes. It is constructed from a densely woven base consisting of Asbestos Yarn and Alloy Wire. The wire is uniformly distributed across the width and along the length of the lining. It is thoroughly impregnated with a special chemical bond and cured under high temperature to withstand the frictional heat present under modern braking



conditions. Both surfaces are ground to close tolerances, making possible a close fit to the brake shoe and uniform contact with the brake drum.

Ferodo "FZ" is recommended for internal brakes generally on those passenger cars, trucks and buses using sizes up to and including 6 x $\frac{1}{8}$, except those with a high degree of servo action, where it is used in combination with other Ferodo linings.
