THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

To the Honorable THE FEDERAL TRADE COMMISSION,

—GREETING:

WHEREAS, lately in the FEDERAL TRADE COMMISSION,
before you or some of you, in a cause between Norristown Magnesia and Asbestos
Company, a corporation, and Sall Mountain Company, a corporation,
Petitioners, and Federal Trade Commission, Respondent, an order to
cease and desist was entered on the 27th day of April, 1944,

AND WHEREAS, the said Norristown Magnesia and Asbestos Company and
Sall Mountain Company
petitioned this court as appears by inspection of the transcript of record of the said FEDERAL
TRADE COMMISSION which was brought into the United States Circuit Court of Ap-
peals for the Sixth Circuit by virtue of a petition to review agree-
ably in the Act of Congress, in such cases made and provided, fully and at large appears.

AND WHEREAS, in the present term of October, in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred
and forty-six the said cause came on to be heard before the said United States
Circuit Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit, on the said transcript of record, and was argued by counsel;

ON CONSIDERATION WHEREOF, It is now here ordered, adjudged and
decreed by this Court that the order of the said Federal Trade
Commission be and it is hereby affirmed.

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YOU, THEREFORE, ARE HEREBY COMMANDED that such proceedings be had in said cause, in conformity with the opinion and decree of this court, as according to right and justice, and the laws of the United States, ought to be had, the said petition to review notwithstanding.
