Dear Ron,

The Mayer and Church article about "Industrial Hygiene Aspects of Mechanical Operations in a Petroleum Refinery", appeared in Med. Bull. 21: 256-265 (1961). We were unable to figure this one out last week, and it is one of the table 1 refs (insulator-users/asbestosis).

In the same obscure NIOSH print-out bibliography that this one was on, I found another fistful of good refs, principally textbook refs on cancer in the 50's, and one excellent one by Mayers/1952 which, I believe speaks to the issue of TLV's for carcinogens and names asbestos as one. For the trouble of relocating these hard-sought and lost refs again, Bob's bill will run up even more; and, coupled with the need to review in a separate library the Factory Inspector's reports for 40 years, I feel you should advance additional funds for the project. I have in mind an expense addition on the order of the cost of translating one foreign reference, \$250.00.
