11 specific questions concerning Mr. Grewe. I would like
12 to ask you some similar questions concerning Mr.
13 Wood.

14 Do you -- I know at the time the deposition
15 was taken that you did not have any specific
16 information concerning Mr. Wood or where he worked.

17 Is that still true for today?

18 A That is still true, yes.
