RE: OSHA Required Labeling for
PVC and VCM; MEETING NOTICE

Gentlemen:

As you are aware, the United States Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit has denied the petitions for review of the OSHA Standard for Exposure to Vinyl Chloride. The Court's decision, issued January 31, 1975, allows 60 days lead time for implementation of the Standard. Accordingly, the new effective date is April 1, 1975.

The Working Committee of the PVC/VCM Ad Hoc Study Group met on January 23, 1975, to review the results of the November, 1974 meeting of the full Committee and further to determine whether any additional steps may be appropriate. The Working Committee concluded that standardization of labeling practices is desirable. Furthermore, in order to implement a standardized approach and to assure that the recommended approach satisfies the regulation, the Working Committee believes that the industry should seek to obtain OSHA's concurrence with the recommended approach. The Minutes of the January 23 meeting of the Working Committee are enclosed herewith.

In order to further discuss the recommendations of the Working Committee and to discuss other problems of implementation of the OSHA Standard, Chairman Tom Smith has requested a meeting of all members of the PVC/VCM
