Attached are two options we are considering for labeling PCB's to UK, Europe and the Far East. We prefer to show only the St. Andrews cross with the reference text "Harmful substances in the various languages." Would this provide port of entry compliance with the Council of Europe requirement?

The precautionary instructions in English we have used on chlorinated hydrocarbons for years should satisfy the spirit and intent of appropriate precautionary measures.

The paragraph regarding environmental problems specifically eliminates incineration of waste fluid because facilities will not be available in the Far East and South America. Your customers are aware of facilities available to them.

We will look to you for additional labeling if it is necessary to provide more extensive copy in multilanguages.
