

...to be carried toward the United States by the wind. Some of them are known to have landed or dropped explosives in isolated localities but without damage to property.

The statement described the attacks as "so scattered and aimless that they do not constitute a military threat." It added: "They should not be viewed with alarm. Due to the large areas of the United States and the variable nature of the winds, the possibility of a hit in any specific area is remote. The chance that any given place would be hit by these attacks is only one in many millions."

"SAFETY" DRIVE

The joint statement said the attacks were being "revealed" to the general public to start a safety campaign which would prevent possible injury or damage from the balloons. The general public already knew all that was "revealed." Newspapers had known for months.

Congress Studies Cuban Sugar Cut

WASHINGTON, May 22.—(AP)—The House Food Committee tonight investigated reports that the Cuban Government has ordered 1945 sugar production curtailed at a time when world stocks are approaching their lowest ebb.

"We're going to look into this," said Committee Chairman Anderson, Democrat of New Mexico, "to see whether Cuba is limiting sugar production."

The United States has bought the 1945 Cuban crop but the two countries have not come to price terms on the 1946 production.

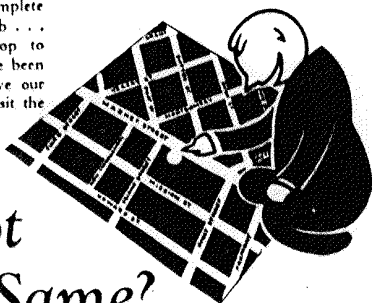
