

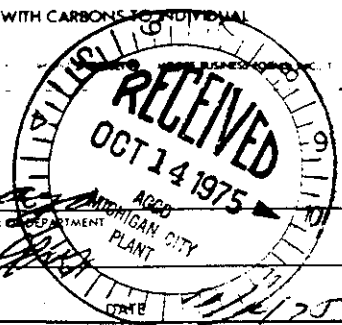

1. Personal Hygiene - wash before eating, drinking or smoking.
Do not carry any type of tobacco in the operating area.
Clean off clothes before entering eating or living areas.
2. Change clothes if abnormally dirty.
Keep finger nails clean.
3. Working Area
Use respirators when required and whenever
there are dusty conditions.
4. Change filters in respirators daily.
Wash respirators daily before use.
Do not let respirators lay out in the shop.
5. Control dust.
Store respirators in a plastic sealed bag.
Clean up spills when they happen rather
6. than scattering throughout the plant.
