On December 19, 2023, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") performed an inspection at Sanborn Lane regarding compliance with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System program of the Clean Water Act. A copy of the inspection report is enclosed with this letter. As we discussed on site, the Low Erosivity Waiver does not apply to this site and will thus be terminated.
