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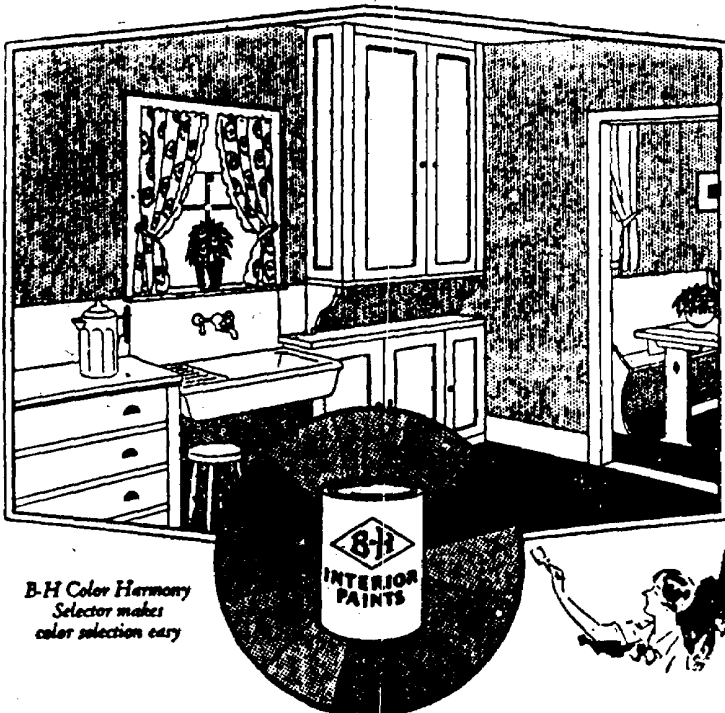

Old-fashioned housewives considered a large earthen crock the best container for bread. The lid of such crocks had a perforation. Bread should never be kept in a cloth.
