Hi Vaughn, for attribution to an EPA spokesperson:

Has EPA determined whether Chemours has violated the terms of the 2009 consent order issued under the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) for the production of GenX?

EPA has initiated an investigation into Chemours' compliance with a 2009 order issued under the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) for the production of GenX. This investigation will allow EPA to determine whether Chemours is in compliance with requirements of the order to control releases to the environment at the Fayetteville, N.C., facility.

Has EPA determined whether there have been any other violations by Chemours?

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As noted previously, the investigation is still ongoing. It's EPA policy not to discuss ongoing investigations.

Has EPA updated the risk assessment for GenX?

EPA is currently in the process of updating the risk assessment for GenX and an associate chemical that were initially assessed when submitted as Pre-Manufacture Notices. New information, including 1) updated production volume, process information, and monitoring data, 2) toxicity studies required by the Consent Order, 3) new water monitoring data and 4) updated manufacturing, processing and use information are all being considered in this reassessment.
