SUBJECT: COSTS.

While the United States is not at war, it is obvious that any extended war in Europe will inevitably increase costs of materials, labor, etc.

Reports are already current of increases in commodities sold thru the trade thru which licensed products move.

It is my belief that no radical change in prices can be justified at the moment but Licensees should place themselves in position to supply supporting data in the event higher prices become necessary thru higher costs.
