Dear Mrs. Martin:

Your letter of June 9, 1970, concerning the safety of Du Pont Duco® Hi-Gloss Enamel for use on baby furniture, has been sent to me for reply.

Although you did not specify the color you used, I have reviewed the basic formula for the subject paint and can assure you that there are no significant amounts of toxic material such as lead, mercury or arsenic in the dried paint. The Duco® Hi-Gloss Enamels are perfectly safe for use on baby furniture.

Because the paint does contain hydrocarbon solvents, I would like to caution you to use it only with adequate ventilation and, of course, prevent any infant from breathing the vapors while you are painting.
