From publically available information, RE-Powering America's Land tracks renewable energy installations developed on formerly contaminated lands, landfills and mine sites on its Tracking Matrix (<https://www.epa.gov/re-powering/re-powering-tracking-matrix>) which includes a table listing the various projects. There is a "Former Use Description" field in that table that will help you identify those projects that were built on MSW landfills.

This site provides links to summaries of a number of revitalized superfund sites that include landfill sites.
