

Ky Hints Shift in Viet Government

SAIGON — Premier "After battle," the pro-Nguyen Cao Ky has suggested that the troops created that there might be able to go in a number of changes in these places for a little rest and amusement.

The premier, hinting that the country's military command might also be reorganized, said that he would make a "major policy speech" on a nationwide radio network soon, possibly on Friday, he gave no details.

His comments were made in an informal conversation with reporters at Saigon's Tan Son Nhut Airport Monday afternoon. He was at the airport to greet the South Korean premier, Yi Kwun Chung, who arrived here for a two-day state visit.

Favors Brothels

On another subject, Premier Ky expressed concern about recreation facilities for front-line United States troops. He said he would favor the creation of controlled brothels in remote areas, with prostitutes to be examined periodically by United States military physicians.

There is a precedent in this country for such facilities. The French army carried with it several bordellos mobile (mobile bordellos) during many of its engagements between 1945 and 1954, including the siege of Dien Bien Phu.

Pleasure Camps The premier said that he was thinking of opening rest and pleasure camps with bars and bar girls so that American combat soldiers would have some place to drink, dance and relax. Many of these troops find it impossible to visit Saigon or any other sizable city very frequently.

This is especially true, Premier Ky added, in the mountainous central region of South Viet Nam, where the United States First Cavalry Division (Airborne), a brigade of the 101st Airborne Division and other units are stationed.

Californians Write Record Checks to Pay Their Bills

SAN FRANCISCO (AP) — Californians are writing checks this year at a record 12-month rate of \$210 billion to pay the butcher, the baker, the mortgage maker, and other dealers in goods and services.

The California Bankers Association said today a statewide survey shows that clearing checks on California banks would reach the \$210 billion total by Dec. 31.

The total will not include checks cashed and cleared in home banks without reaching clearing houses. These gather, sort and send checks to the banks on which they are drawn.

The Los Angeles and San Francisco clearing houses handle more than 90 per cent of all checks in the state. The remainder are cleared through 16 other cities.

By the end of August, the Los Angeles clearing house had totaled \$22.29 billion for 1965. It expects to top \$110 billion by the end of the year with about \$400 million clearing every business day.

The San Francisco clearing house expects a year end total of about \$190 billion, up about \$25 billion over 1964.

Californians match the national trend of paying by check about \$ 9 of every \$10 they owe, said Frank M. Dana, association president.
