PERUVIAN OCHRE:

we acknowledge receipt of your night message of the 5th inst., requesting us to order one car Georgia Peruvian Ochre packed in barrels, same quality as sample submitted with our letter #2045, and note your instructions to ship immediately by cheapest route.

Order has been placed with the Georgia Peruvian Ochre Co. We are investigating freight rates, as we believe there will be a considerable saving by having shipment made to one of the Southern Ports to connect with steamer for San Francisco. As you know, these goods are fob Cartersville, Ga. and it would be prohibitive to have shipment brought to any of the Eastern Ports for steamer shipment.

Will advise later just what action we have taken in this matter.
