

1           A     Yes.

2           Q     Now, based upon the material that was sent  
3     to you for your review by the plaintiffs, you are  
4     aware, are you not, that Mr. Grewe had other potential  
5     asbestos exposures than just to brake and clutch  
6     work?

7                     MR. IGNATOWSKI:  Objection.

8                     THE COURT:  Sustained.

9                     BY MR. WILLIAMS:

10          Q     Now, Doctor, as your work as a pathologist  
11     in this case, because you were unable to -- because  
12     you were not forwarded any lung parenchyma, you were  
13     unable to really determine exactly what types of  
14     asbestos fibers were present in Mr. Grewe's lungs?

15                    MR. IGNATOWSKI:  Objection.  Asked and  
16     answered, Your Honor, I believe.

17                    THE COURT:  For the final time, he can  
18     answer the question.

19                    All right.  Overruled.  Go ahead.

20          A     That is correct.

21          Q     So just -- strike that.
