I hope you are well. I am contacting you on behalf of the Environment Committee of the American Chamber of Commerce to the EU (AmCham EU) to **invite you to a meeting with a small group of our members** to discuss the ongoing PFAS restriction that the Netherlands is leading. We have already been in contact regarding the workshop you organised at the end of the year and are thankful that AmCham EU could participate.

We would be very interested in meeting you to hear from you how the work on the PFAS restriction is progressing and have an exchange of views on this important file for industry. As AmCham EU, we fully support the objectives of the European Green Deal, and have been continued, active stakeholders on chemicals, recently publishing [our position on the Chemicals Strategy for Sustainability](#), including a summary of our views on PFAS.

In regard to the format of the meeting, we would suggest a 60-minute intervention, in the form of a short introduction to your work, followed by an informal Q&A session with a small group of our members most active on PFAS files, held under Chatham House rules. We are however flexible to structure the meeting in the way that you find most comfortable. Regarding the platform, we are able to meet virtually via both Microsoft Teams or WebEx, so please feel free to highlight your preference.

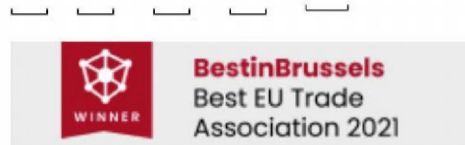
