We agree that the air rates for asbestos are too high even though we should get an order for White CerteX. We do have the figures to show in the event we are asked why we can't make a shipment by a certain length of time.

For Mr. Brown's information we still are not sure that the asbestos used in the trial shipment was the right material. Mr. Doyle of Phillip Cary tells us the plant screen tests correspond to a 7 TF grade which may have been shipped by mistake and marked 7 RF-9. He is having another 200 lbs sent to Acme for another trial. This time make up the charge of 9lb in back of either Bedding or All Purpose to avoid getting any color from a previous batch of topping or joint cement. Send us a gallon can from the batch. We may decide to make a repeat field trial if the first one isn't successful.

Also make up a batch of 905 with the rest of the 200 lbs., and send us a gallon can of it and the results of your tests on the 7 RF-9 asbestos and the materials made with it. It will be about three weeks before you get this asbestos.
