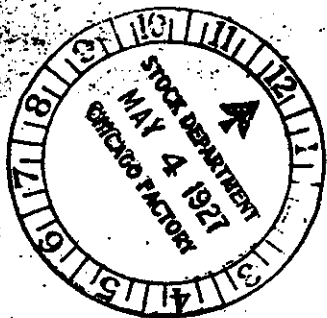
Black Center Line Marking Paint is a mixture  
of refined tar pitch and light tar distillate oil meet-  
ing these specifications:

- 1- When tested in an Engler Viscosimeter the  
specific viscosity ranges from 10 to 20 at 25° C.  
(77° F.)
- 2- On distillation it shows from 35 to 45 per-  
cent of distillate up to 300° C.
- 3- Water content less than 1%.
- 4- The drying time at 70° F. is from one-half  
to one hour, at the end of which period there will be  
no pickup by traffic. The paint is dry and free from  
tackiness within one hour after application.
- 5- Color is a dense lustrous black.
- 6- Black Center Line Marking Paint may be ap-  
plied as is with either a brush or marking machine.
- 7- Thin with Black Center Line Marking Paint Re-  
ducer (Ebenol Reducer 02910) if necessary.

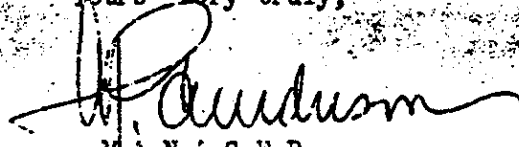
