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I have reviewed the Industrial Hygiene Digest issues I have for the following months during the period that GATX was a member of the Air Hygiene Foundation (as it was called until 1941): 10 and 12, 1937; 1-3, 5-6, 9-12, 1938; and 1, 1939. There were many abstracts on dust sampling and dust control engineering, but I have only copied those that specifically mention asbestos. There was also one that referred to dust control work apparently reported by GATX, on the use of covered hopper cars to permit dust suppression by companies using railcars full of powdered arsenic or silica, etc. (cover page, Jan. 1938). Two hours of my bill is for examining these documents; I think the other 4 issues in this time period are available at the National Library of Medicine, which you may wish to examine if you want to see what they contain.
