This price includes equipment, personnel, disposal and OSHA required air monitoring for Eco Environmental's employees.

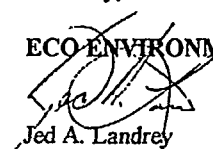

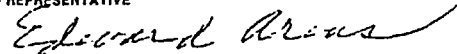
