

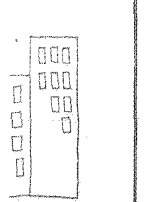

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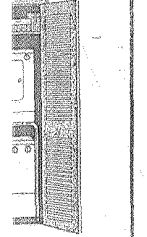
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State Supt. of Public Instruction Max Rafferty said in Monterey yesterday that nobody wants compulsory busing of students except judges and some people in the American Civil Liberties Union.

Campaigning for re-election to a third term, Rafferty addressed more than 100 of his followers at a luncheon at the Outrigger Restaurant in Monterey. Rafferty said the demand for compulsory busing to achieve racial balance in schools originates entirely outside of schools, and that parents, regardless of race, do not want to see their youngsters bused across "roaring freeways" just for the sake of racial balance.

Courts He charged that the courts are not only telling schools that they must bus students for racial reasons but that "they are telling us how to administer our schools after busing."

Rafferty described a typical hippie or revolutionary-type student and said that there was a time when a teacher could tell such a student "to shape up or ship out."

Teacher Control There is a crying need in schools today, Rafferty said, to establish a rapport between teacher and students with the teacher in control. But this relationship, he charged, is being destroyed by the decisions of judges.

"Sure, we have some bad teachers but we also have some bad judges," Rafferty declared.

He said that unless there are changes the classroom

will become "a cross between a burlesque house and a hippie and a series of strikes."

On other matters, Rafferty deplored teacher strikes. He said that California teachers have the best pay scales and the best living conditions of teachers anywhere in the country and that he feels the present period of strikes is only temporary.

Rafferty said that some years ago he was charged with coming up with a solution to the controversy over sex education in public schools. He said that he came up with it; that it parents in a district want it they will have it, that it they do not they will not.

Now, he said, he anticipates that he will be told to come up with a solution to the question of "sensitivity training." This will be harder, he suggested. "Everyone knows about sex. But what do you know about your sensitivity?" he asked.

Reading Rafferty said that in the eight years he has headed the state schools system he has rid it of the "Dick and Jane" syndrome in reading instruction and has gotten back to a point where they are in fact learning to read again.

Under his regime, Rafferty said reading scores of California students had deteriorated for 20 years under the "Dick and Jane" or look-say system of reading.

Red Schoolhouse He said the "little red schoolhouse of 100 years ago may have had its faults but at least everyone in the little red schoolhouse could learn to read."

Rafferty also said that if re-elected, he will work to restore the financial contribution of the state to local schools to the 50-50 level it had many years ago. The state, at present, he said, is contributing only 35 per cent, with the remaining share falling upon the local property taxpayer.

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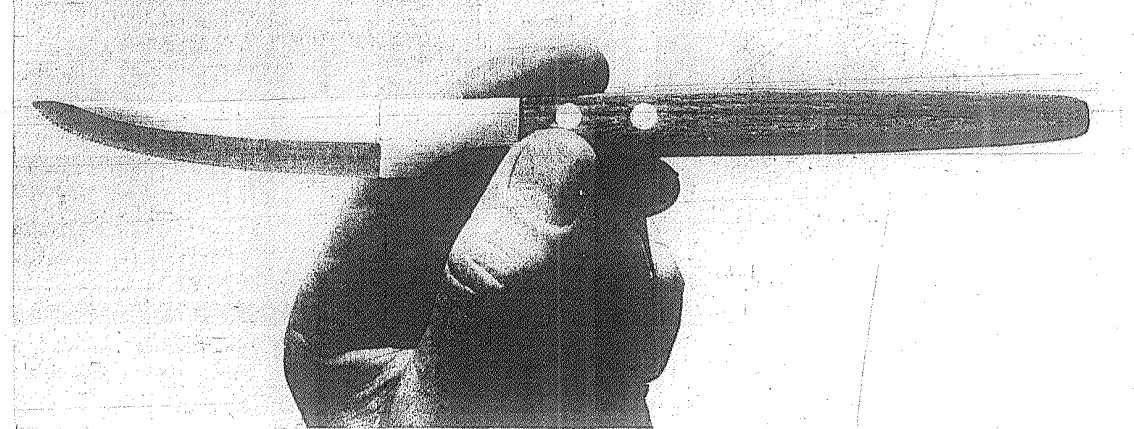
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
