The dust counts were completed on the samples collected at Shop No. 2 and Works No. 4, Pittsburgh Plate Glass Company, Ford City, Pennsylvania.

Samples of resin-glass fibre dust from the Owens Corning Corporation were sieved and taken to the Bureau of Mines for explosion tests.

The reports covering the surveys of Anaconda Wire and Cable Company at Marion, Indiana and Anderson, Indiana were completed.

A conference was held with Mr. Arthur Masters of Thompson and Company, Oakmont, Pennsylvania regarding possible substitutes for the skin irritants present in their nail coating compound.
