Reveals Sabotage Plot To British Army.

KHARTOUM, Anglo-Egyptian
 Sudan, April 5 (AP)—Ras Seyoum,
 doughty black-bearded Ethio-
 pian noble who was Italy's most
 stubborn foe in 1935-36 but who
 later was appointed governor of
 a province by the fascist ruler
 through the British, now in
 Asmara today and arrested, he
 had been sabotaging the Italian
 efforts for five years.

Seyoum is hereditary ruler of
 Tigre province and father-in-
 law of Ethiopia's crown prince.
 As a boy, he witnessed the
 slaughter of the Italians at
 Adowa in 1936. When the Italo-
 nians invaded his country again
 in 1941, he fought with such
 fury and skill that fascist gen-
 erals openly accused him of
 sabotage.

Finally, in 1941 he made his
 peace with the British and
 went to Rome. Premier Musso-
 lini treated him as a traitor and
 turned out 25,000 Italian
 troops for a job near a British
 base.

Seyoum said he then was
 secretly working for the British
 in the Asmara region. The
 British announced that he was
 one of the leaders of a native
 army opposing the British.

Instead, Seyoum declared to-
 day, he duped the British com-
 pletely. They gave him large
 quantities of rifles, which he
 said were smuggled promptly
 to Tigre province to arm his old
 anti-Italian warriors.

Finally, when the British
 swept through historic Adowa,
 Seyoum slipped away and of-
 fered his services to the imperial
 command.

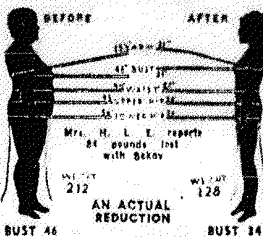

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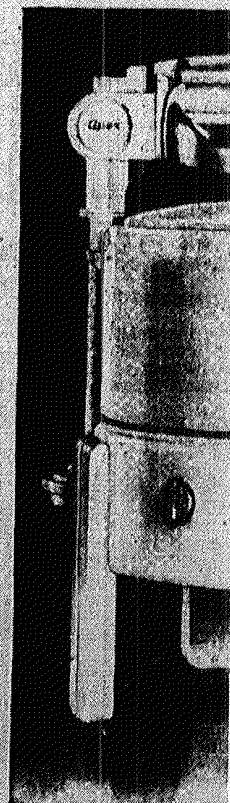
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
