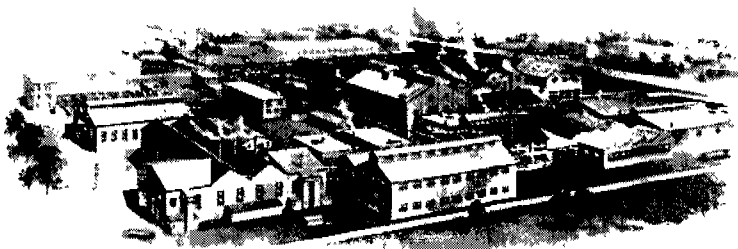

Dear Mr. Bogart:

Your letter of January 29 to Mr. M. F. Crass, Jr., regarding your problem in obtaining delivery of a Kiln and Cooler has been referred to me. It so happens that many problems of this nature are being handled in this office, and I am pleased to give you whatever assistance is possible at this time.

As you do not require structural steel or other controlled materials for plant construction, it may be that you will need a priority rating for the Kiln and Cooler in order to permit your supplier, the Traylor Engineering & Manufacturing Co., to go ahead with production of your equipment. The best procedure for getting this at this time would be to write to the Chemical Division of National Production Authority attention Mr. Stanley R. Galbraith, Room 2Y14, New GAO Building, Washington 25, D. C. I would suggest that you document your case as completely as possible. This should include complete information on what you have done so far to obtain this equipment, where you have placed the order, and description of the equipment. Also, explain the need and what you are planning to produce, the end use of the chemical that will be produced, and why it is necessary in the industrial economy and the mobilization program. The latter is of considerable importance for them to justify full support of your case, and if you can tie this up with needs of one of the Armed Services, it should be so indicated.

It is my understanding that the Chemical Division of NPA would be your claimant agency in getting priority assistance for you. In an effort to further assist you, I tried to reach one of the men in the chemical equipment group of the Industrial Equipment Division, but I was not successful. He must, of course, obtain a go-ahead from the chemical group but it occurred to me that if he also got a copy of your letter, it might be of some assistance. His name is James Lawson and if you should care to do so, you can send me the copy and I will forward it on to him with a short explanatory note.
