Subject Checklist for Protection
Against Inhalation of
Asbestos Fibers

Mr. W. A. Burnette of the Central Insulation Group has prepared a checklist for insulators to use as protection against inhalation of asbestos fibers. This checklist with a summary of the reasons for protection and the effect on the body if exposures to asbestos occur is applicable for all personnel working with this material in the Institute Plant. The checklist should be followed for protection of personnel and complying with OSHA regulation 1910.93a.

The tags are not yet stocked in stores and personnel are requested to write information on yellow "Caution" tags until a supply of tags is available. These have been ordered.

Air sampling will be performed by the Industrial Hygiene Department both for asbestos and other insulation nuisance dusts at the discretion of the industrial hygienist and/or during jobs involving large quantities of asbestos demolition.
