Re memo to, Mr. Sullivan's letter of June 10, 1964 in answer to your inquiry of June 10. The indicated approval of the note being printed on the back of applied by the use of a sticker label. You are aware that the label also will be a little expensive, up to half the cost of the label, due mainly to the amount of time to affix the label.

For your information, our supply of printed Standard format tags would last 9 months at the rate of usage in the first six months this year. On the Chicago tag, we have 4,900 on hand and have had no usage during the first six months of this year. Actually, we have had only 200 tags in the last six years. We still have the original supply purchased in 1950. Hence this product needs a little attention to get it back into circulation.
