You doubtless will recall the case of Mr. [REDACTED] whose death was found due to tetraethyl poisoning. It was my understanding that you thought settlement could be made out of court so that his children might receive some compensation.

His mother, Mrs. [REDACTED], has taken the matter up with the Orange State Oil Company. She was referred by them to the insurance company and by them to the State Industrial Commission. They told her it did not come under their sphere and advised her to consult an attorney. I wonder if you have any suggestion as to what steps she might take to settle this without engaging an attorney.
