Draft Position Statement--Bomb Threat

This morning, afternoon, evening at approximately time,
Monsanto's Carondelet Plant received an anonymous telephone
call or hand written message alleging that a bomb has or had
been planted somewhere in this facility.

Monsanto has contacted or contacted the St. Louis Police,
the Bomb/Arson Squad and the Fire Department. The police
will be here momentarily to investigate the threat or are
currently here investigating the threat.

Also, since receiving the call or message, Monsanto is
taking or has taken several operating precautions within the
plant to protect our employees and the surrounding community
and to secure the facility.

As update information on the police investigation of the
plant becomes available, we will share it with you.
If additional emergency procedures need to be taken in the
community, the authorities will communicate that to you
immediately.

OR

Based upon the thorough investigation of the plant by the
City Police and the Bomb/Arson Squad, an all-clear was given
at approximately time. However, given the nature of the
situation and based on the recommendations of the police, it
would be inappropriate for Monsanto to go into much more
detail about the incident.
